The Scottish Child Abuse Inquiry heard the man took condoms with him when he took pupils from Aberlour House in Moray on an expedition in the 1980s. The latest phase of the inquiry is focusing on alleged abuse carried out in Scottish boarding schools.

Aberlour House is considered to be a prep school for Gordonstoun. The inquiry began hearing evidence relating to Gordonstoun School and heard

discovered the group was one tent short. As a result, it was decided that some pupils would have to share a tent with the man leading the expedition, who was aged 19 or 20, and they would take it in turns to sleep in his tent.

two other girls shared the tent with him and he began to do things. They left and he raped you." Sarah replied: "Yes".
