In Paris, **Minima Gesté will carry the flame on July 14**. For the time being, neither its route nor the time of its passage is known, for safety reasons. A case to be continued!

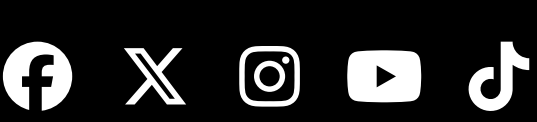
